The HUB in 2025

2025 was the first full year where we have housed a HUB for Mission Central. It has been a busy year with over 40 different volunteers. We have received many donations for the buckets and cleaning kits as well as some monetary donations. All of these resources will help families who are experiencing natural disasters as they begin their cleanup.

This year, the *Palmyra First Church* HUB donated 447 hygiene kits, 204 cleaning buckets, several bags of personal toiletries, some medical supplies, two computers, and a bag of school supplies. In addition, we presented a \$500 check to Mission Central.

We have had some very generous donations from church members and Weis Markets bakery. Without the support of many members at *First Church*, we would not have been able to accomplish so much. We hope to make an even greater impact in 2026. We are going to try packing every other month during the new year to ease some of the supply issues.
